Begun in 1595 in Lincolnshire by the eminent Elizabethan architect, Robert Smythson, Doddington Hall was completed in 1600. We will have a private guided tour of both the House and Gardens on a day when they are not open to the public. The House tour will highlight the impressive collections of furniture, paintings, weaponry and textiles. There is also time on your own to visit the Nature Trails and Estate Walks, Farm Shop, five acres of gardens including the Kitchen Garden as well as a Gift Shop, Home Store and various restaurants.
